

## **> Outreach/Volunteer Coordinator – Buffalo, NY**

The Outreach and Volunteer Coordinator's primary responsibilities are to build community collaborations, referral relationships, conduct a variety of outreach activities, develop promotional/marketing materials and recruit and retain volunteers for various functions of the Recovery Center. Master's Degree in Human Services plus two year of advocacy experience in a human service agency or health care facility OR Bachelor's Degree and 4 years experience in a human service agency or health care facility. Must have personal "lived" experience with prevention, treatment or mental health services or have personal substance use recovery experience and be comfortable with self-disclosure as needed. Clean NYS Driver's license required. Certification as a provisional or full QHP or peer preferred. Bilingual English/Spanish preferred.

## **> Teachers – Various Schools**

The Building Brighter Futures program is looking for qualified Certified Teachers and Educational majors to teach/tutor in our afterschool programming. We offer our students a rich and varied experience that includes academics that align and compliment the academics offered during the school day. Teaching license/certification preferred. Pay commensurate with education, experience and licensing/certification. After School PT hours (vary 2pm-5pm or 3pm-6pm), Monday-Friday.

## **> After School Enrichment Leaders – Various Schools**

The Building Brighter Futures program is looking for qualified individuals to be Enrichment Leaders and help conduct our rich and varied Social and Emotional Learning-based afterschool programming in Buffalo Public Schools. Our programming runs between 2 and hours after the end of the school day, depending on the school, and includes academics as well as various enrichment activities. Teaching or instructional experience with children or youth. Pay commensurate with education and licensing/certifications. After School PT hours vary 2pm-5pm or 3pm-6pm, Monday-Friday.

## **> Registered Nurse – Niagara St., Buffalo**

The Primary Care Integration RN provides initial and ongoing assessments of clients, including client history, evaluation of problems, and formulation of diagnosis. The RN is responsible for a variety of medical and psychiatric functions including: medical assessments and education, coordination of community-based health care, psychiatric assessment, crisis intervention, psychotropic and medical medication administration and monitoring. The RN participates in and supports patient care with emphasis on patient response including triaging and timely follow up on medical concerns, referrals and diagnostic testing. Plan, modify care and implement interventions as needed and communicate appropriately with patient. The Primary Care Integration RN must be a graduate of an approved of a registered nursing program. BSN preferred. Must have current NYS nursing license.

## **> MICA Specialist – Fredonia, NY**

The ACT MICA Specialist Provides direct, intensive screening and treatment to mentally ill chemical abusing individuals accepted into the ACT Program. The MICA Specialist provides both one-to-one and group modality treatment as well as crisis intervention. The MICA Specialist develops and implements treatment plans providing direct clinical services in a variety of modalities, with focus on chemical dependency intervention, and participates in crisis intervention strategies. Possesses a Master's degree in Social Work, Psychology, Rehabilitation Counseling. Professional (QHP) certification meeting NYS Office of Mental Health definition for professional staff. 1 year relevant experience.

## **> Customer Service Rep. (BILINGUAL)**

Responsible for the day-to-day secretarial, data processing, and clerical duties of the program. Performs all required reception duties, typing, filing, transcription, and computer operation, insurance verifications as well as other general office activities. High School diploma or equivalency, including or supplemented by courses in typing and computer operations AND one year full-time paid experience performing some combination of secretarial and data entry duties along with experience with medical insurance and verifications preferred OR Graduation from two-year business school with courses in typing and computer operations.

## **> Social Emotional Coordinator – Building Brighter Futures (BPS #93 & Various Schools)**

The SEC will promote the program into the classroom and BBF afterschool program providing de-escalation, behavior management and mediation to students individually and in small groups. Will teach preventive programs such as Second Step, Safe Dates, anti-bullying workshops, etc. Minimum BSW and 2 years' experience. FT, Monday-Friday position.

## **> Mental Health Counselor (BILINGUAL) – Buffalo, NY**

The MH Counselor provides assessment, treatment planning, crisis and on-going therapeutic treatment interventions for the clients who are mentally ill. Clients served may or may not have a dual diagnosis of mental illness and chemical abuse or mental illness and mental retardation. (LCSW preferred, LMSW, LMHC) plus a minimum of 1 year of professional work experience in a clinical mental health setting. Site qualifies NHSC loan forgiveness site for LMHC and LCSWs.
