Responsibility:

This includes analyzing in-process parameters such as scrap, capability, cycle time, etc. Tasks will vary from conducting tests on the manufacturing floor at an operator level, to presenting studies at a management level.

- Ability to work, lead, and mentor in a cross-function team setting, and work on multiple projects simultaneously.
- Strong verbal, written, and presentation skills.
- Able to effectively manage projects. Be driven by known project constraints, due dates, and cost goals.
