ADVANCED MANUFACTURING CAREER PATHWAY

What to expect in this training program:

- Mondays and Tuesdays of every week starting March 12, 2018 trainees will report to their employer partner for a full 8-10 hour work day **
- Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays trainees will report to Erie 1 BOCES on Walden Avenue for classroom training from 8am—3:30pm

**transportation support may be available to eligible candidates

What you can get out of this training program:

- A nationally recognized certification
- Earn up to \$2,000.00 in wages while learning a new skill
- Earn up to \$900 tax free for 100% attendance at the worksite and in the classroom
- Earn \$150 for passing a mandatory drug test and completing the 12-week program
- Gain work experience with a local manufacturing company which may lead to full-time employment

What you need to do to be successful:

- Be drug free and able to pass a mandatory drug test necessary to work with an employer partner
- Visit Erie 1 BOCES to take a placement exam
- Meet with a representative from the Department of Labor to determine eligibility

Who can apply:

- Men and women who are 18 years or older and have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Individuals who are currently unemployed or earning a wage that doesn't support their needs
- Individuals who have been justice involved
