Preventive Services Counselor **Supervised Visitation Program**

Scope:

To provide supervised visitation and related casework services to families involved in the foster care and court system where children have been removed for abuse or neglect. To assist families in meeting the goals of family reunification and improved parenting skills as appropriate.

Essential duties:

- Provide supervised visits to non-custodial parents and their children.
- Provide case management and counseling as needed.
- Provide documentation and contract requirements in compliance with Erie County Department of Social Services.
- Generate up-to-date research on relevant client areas i.e., domestic violence, mental health issues, drug and alcohol abuse, child abuse and neglect.
- Participate in internal supervisory case reviews, staff meetings, trainings, etc.
- Ability to work effectively with contract partners, supervisory staff, other staff members, etc.

Minimum Education & Experience:

Level 3 – Bachelor's Degree in related field plus 1-3 years casework experience.

Special Skills:

Prior experience with NYS Connections desired. Individual must be willing to work some early evening hours, if required. Position has both internal contacts within the organization and external contacts within the community, which require considerable tact, courtesy and diplomacy.
