



Now Hiring Van Driver

Responsibilities: The Family Promise of WNY Van Driver is a part-time position that is responsible for safely transporting families in shelter between our Day Center and faith communities in our network across Erie County. This position is part-time (20 hours/week) for variable weeks of the year up to 28 weeks total. Guests need to be safely transported each morning and late afternoon in a 15-passenger van back and forth between our Day Center located in downtown Buffalo and a host faith community in our network located across Erie County.

Other responsibilities include:

- Keep van filled with gas via a company credit card
- Report any van maintenance problems to FPWNY staff
- Van must be retrieved and parked at our Day Center location each day

Requirements:

- Maintain an excellent driving record and keep a valid driver's license on file with FPWNY
- Comfort driving a 15-passenger van in all kinds of weather
- Reliable and timely
- Prioritize safety in all matters, including not abusing drugs or alcohol while working
- Personality suited to working with families and children under stress, including patience, flexibility and positivity.
- Background check required
- Although this position does not require a special license, we prefer candidates have significant driving experience

Hours and Compensation:

- Hours for this position run from 5:45am-7:45am and from 4:00-6:00pm Monday-Friday during variable weeks up to 28 weeks/year depending on shelter rotation schedule.
- Minimum wage (\$10.40/hour)
