

## **City of Buffalo is looking for Crossing Guards**

-Crossing Guards are paid \$10.15/hour and are paid for 2 hours for each shift worked. Each shift, morning and afternoon, averages about 1 hour long.

-When a Crossing Guard is in a permanent appointment, he/she is eligible for health care benefits after 90 days of employment; the employee does pay a percentage of these benefits.

-The Buffalo Police Department manages the daily oversight of Crossing Guards, including corner assignment. Proximity of a Crossing Guard's house to their corner along with the need at a particular corner is taken into consideration when assigning Guards to corners.

-Once a Crossing Guards are given a permanent assignment, this will be the corner they return to year after year, unless a transfer is requested.

-The specific time of a Crossing Guard's shift depends on the start and end times of the school close to the corner they are working at.

-Crossing Guards are only paid for the shifts they work and are not paid when there is not school, ie-holiday and summer breaks, scheduled days off (Veterans' and Memorial Day, etc.) and unscheduled days off (snow days).
